



Make Your Own Instrument of the Week!

Welcome to our online fun craft feature! Make your own instrument of the week to use in your online Tot Bop class!

This week's instrument ... Tin Can Shaky Man!

Here's how you make him ...

1. Ask Mummy or Daddy for two washed out tuna cans, sticky tape, coloured card and felt tip pens.
2. Start by filling one can with some rice or pasta to make the 'shake'. Then use some sticky tape to stick the other can on top.



3. Next, measure out a strip of coloured card to make the body. It should be the same width as the height of your two cans. Wrap the card around the cans and stick in place.
4. Now you need to make the hands and feet. Using a different colour, draw 4 hands/feet as shown to the left, leaving enough space at the bottom to have a 'tab' to stick on.

5. Cut out your hands and feet and bend up the ends of each to form a tab. Stick them onto the sides and the bottom to make the hands and feet.

6. Do the same to make the eyes and the mouth of your shaky man and stick them on to make the face.



7. Using a black felt tip pen, add your choice of finishing touches to your tin can shaky man, such as the eyes, teeth or eyebrows!
