



Make Your Own Instrument of the Week!

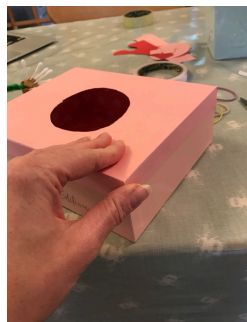
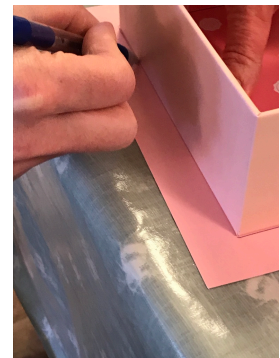
Welcome to our online fun craft feature! Make your own instrument of the week to use in your online Tot Bop class!

This week's instrument ... The Homemade Guitar!

Here's how you make it ...

1. Ask Mummy or Daddy for an old tissue box or shoe box, some card, sticky tape, glue, elastic bands and an old kitchen roll holder.

2. Start by drawing around your box onto the card, leaving about a 2cm gap around each edge. Fold over the lines over.

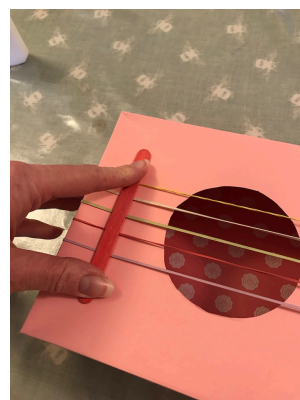


3. Then use a round object to draw a circle in the middle of the card. Cut out the circle to make a hole.

4. Using either double sided sticky tape or normal sticky tape, secure the card to the box and fold over the tabs to make the lid of the guitar.

5. Use 4/5 elastic bands (different colours if you have them) and stretch them over the long side of your guitar. Glue a lollipop stick to hold them in place.

6. On one end of your guitar, glue your kitchen roll holder to make the handle.



7. Have fun putting the final touches to your guitar and decorating it in stickers if you wish. You could chose your old theme ... flowers or superheroes for example.
