



Make Your Own Instrument of the Week!

Welcome to our online fun craft feature! Make your own instrument of the week to use in your online Tot Bop class!

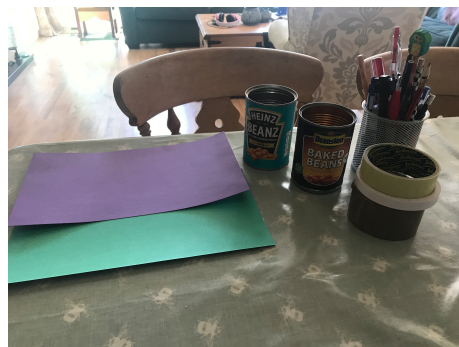
This week's instrument ... Tin Can Drum!

1. Ask Mummy or Daddy for some coloured card (ideally two contrasting colours), a washed out tin can, some string, paints and/or stickers, sticky tape and scissors.

2. Start by measuring out a strip of card (one colour only). The width of your strip should be the same as the height of the tin can. Wrap around your tin can and stick in place with sticky tape.



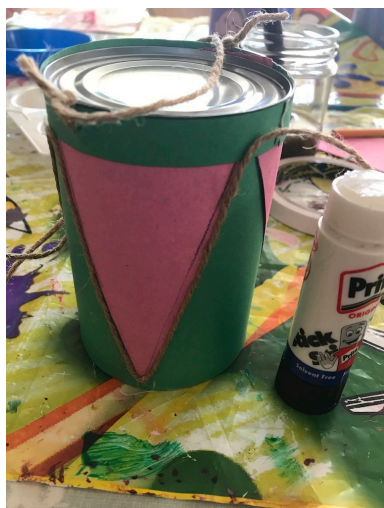
Here's how you make it ...



3. Next, and if you want an alternate colour, cut out triangle shapes on a different coloured card, leaving a strip at the top. (You might choose a different design to triangles.)

4. Attach the triangles to the first coloured card and stick in place with sticky tape.

5. Next cut a strip of card, about 1.5cm wide. Measure it to fit around the top of your tin can and make a mark on card either side of the can. Carefully pierce a whole through both marks and thread through the end of a length of string.



6. Loop the string round and thread through the other whole, securing both ends with a knot. Using sticky tape or glue, attach the strip to the top of your can. Finish with any other decoration you wish ... paint, pictures, stickers!
