



Make Your Own Instrument of the Week!

Welcome to our online fun craft feature! Make your own instrument of the week to use in your online Tot Bop class!

This week's instrument ... Tutti Fruity Kazoo!

1. Ask Mummy or Daddy for an old toilet roll, some paints and brushes, some baking paper and an elastic band.

2. Start by painting your toilet roll white. It makes whatever colour you choose to make your kazoo brighter. Once dry you can then paint it your choice of colour. We chose orange! Leave it to dry.





Here's how you make it ...



3. Once dry you can add your design. We chose an orange but you can choose anything you like; maybe a watermelon or an apple!

4. For our orange, paint an area white and leave to dry again. Then paint the orange 'segments' on top of the white

and dot with white for the pips.







7. Pop your cut out circle of baking paper on the top of your kazoo and fix in place with an elastic band.

Your tutti fruity kazoo is complete!





5. Once your painted design is dry, ask a grown up to help you pierce a hole in the middle of your kazoo. This lets the sound out!

6. Use a small bowl to draw around on some baking paper. Cut out your circle.
