This week's instrument ... Tin Can Shaky Drum!

Here's how you make it ...

1. Ask Mummy or Daddy for an old tin can. It could be a baked bean tin or a used tin of tomatoes. Give it a wash in warm water and peel the label off.
2. Using a clean spoon, scoop a spoonful of uncooked rice, pasta or dried beans/lentils into the can.



3. Use a balloon for the top of the drum. Cut off the bottom of the balloon to leave a bigger opening. Stretch the balloon over the open side of the tin can.



4. Stretch the balloon down the sides of the can until it forms a taught drum on the top and there are no wrinkles.



5. Add an elastic band to the top to secure the balloon in place and to add a little extra colour!

Your tin can shaky drum is complete!
